<b>Requisite Qualification</b>	Master's Degree in Civil / Electrical / Hydropower / Environmental / Water Resources Engineering from HEC recognized University or International University of the high ranking; and registered with the Pakistan Engineering Council.
<b>Age Limit</b>	The minimum age is Forty Five (45) years and maximum age is Sixty-two (62) years.
<b>Experience</b>	The candidate shall have at least Fifteen years' experience in dealing with water sector planning/design/construction projects of national and international repute and contract management. Qualification in project Management, Finance, Corporate Law, Supply Chain Management and IT will be considered as an added advantage.

Review the existing policies, frameworks, constitutional provisions and rules of business of the Ministry with a futuristic approach to identify a gap and suggest improvements/revisions thereof to optimally implement the mandate of the Ministry;</li><li>2. Review of existing mechanisms of water data collection, its publication and analysis and assist in development of an integrated Water Resources Management Information System for improved exchange of primary and secondary information among organizations and to facilitate policy making and harmonized development plans.</li><li>3. Tender expert advice on Interprovincial water issues and review the existing institutional and legal framework of the Federal and Provincial Governments to identify bottlenecks and suggesting practical solutions for integrated water resources management at national level.</li><li>4. Formulate implementation framework for both demand and supply side management (inclusive of Long, Medium and Short-Term plans) with quantifiable targets in line with the National Water Policy.</li><li>5. To oversee development programs of water resources in respect of the Ministry and the organizations under its administrative control with a view to:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Extend technical advice on the overall water related Public Sector Development Programme (PSDP) projects in line with National Water Policy and Sustainable Development Goals.</li><li>b. Initiate and facilitate regular technical meetings on national level to review program implementation, and identify measures to overcome implementation bottlenecks.</li></ol></li></ol>

To coordinate and promote research in the areas of water development, conservation and management as well as to extend guidance in periodically reviewing the national agenda for research in water and water related issues.</p> <p>8. Rendering policy directions relating to trans-boundary water issues within the framework of Indus Water Treaty and International Water Laws.</p> <p>9. Identify new and innovative ideas and develop strategies for priority areas relating to implement the regime of integrated water resource management as well as harnessing the hydro power potential to its optimal level.</p> <p>10.
